Shepparton Motor Museum and Collectibles Ltd – Kialla	The Shepparton Truck and Transport Museum and Events Hub will showcase the Goulburn Valley's rich history and heritage centred on trucking, transport and agriculture. Visitors will be engaged through interactive multimedia and fixed displays, along with curated exhibitions depicting the settlement, growth and establishment of the Goulburn Valley as a major national transport hub and one of the Nation's leading food bowls. This project builds on the success of the Shepparton Motor Museum and Collectibles which has been founded and built by the community in partnership with the private sector. The dedicated Museum and outdoor covered events space will bolster the region's cultural tourism offering along with events capability.	\$2,500,000	\$5,000,000
F.J. Lenne Pty Ltd – Ardmona	This project consists of the construction of new warehouse and office buildings along with the installation of new apple and pear grader and packing equipment. The intended outcome of the new facility is to increase production capacity by 100% of the current production levels. This will allow the business to produce an estimated 60,000 tons of packed fruit per year to meet existing and new demands by both domestic and export markets. Furphy & Sons Pty Ltd – Shepparton	The project involves purchase and installation of a new laser welding machine that will enable production of pillowplate heat exchange panels for existing and new applications. New applications for the manufacture of panels include supply of value added panels to a Victorian company, Raygen, which will revolutionize solar thermal technology.	\$675,000	\$1,350,000

<p>Linking Culture, Environment and People - RiverConnect Shared Paths – Shepparton</p>	<p>The project will extend two of the existing shared path networks between Shepparton and Mooroopna. Route 3 is the Flats, a highly significant area which was settled by the traditional owners following the famous Cummeragunja walk off in 1939. The Flats shared path will continue the interpretive signage, explaining and celebrating the extensive contribution Yorta Yorta have made to the local and national identify. Route 5 will see a vital link to the existing shared path network along the Goulburn River to the Australian Botanic Gardens (ABGS) on the southern side of the Broken River. This will connect the Gardens to the Victoria Park Lake precinct and provide a valuable addition to tourism and recreational opportunities for visitors and locals alike.</p>	<p>\$610,740</p>	<p>\$1,221,480</p>
<p>Rubicon Systems Australia Pty. Ltd – Shepparton</p>	<p>Rubicon are world leaders in the market for production of smart water technology for the agricultural sector. This project plans to increase Rubicon's production capacity through the purchase of an additional piece of machinery for aluminium extrusion machining that will be more efficient, faster and have additional functionality. <p>Turnbull Brothers Orchards Pty Ltd – Tatura East</p>	<p>This innovative, ultra-high-density cherry orchard with new cherry varieties adds more value to precious resources, water, land and labour while boosting employment. The investment will see 3.02ha prepared with state-of-the-art irrigation. Custom-made trellis will help quadruple yield and support rain covers to stop rain damage which can wipe out entire crops. Over 12,000 trees will be planted, trained and pruned into trellised hedges. Greater Shepparton City Council – Dookie	Dookie Rail Trail Stage 2 will provide a unique visitor experience in the Goulburn Valley. The Rail Trail will offer a short, scenic route for walkers and cyclists through a classic Australian cropping landscape. It will be a major tourism drawcard for the region and will have strong economic benefits.	\$275,000	\$550,000
Radnor Corp Pty Ltd – Stanhope	The project will upgrade a derelict mill into a modern and productive rice milling facility which employs locals, reinvigorates the rice industry in Victoria and provides a replacement product to imported rice. Radnor Corp, trading as Forbidden Foods, currently imports, manufactures and distributes boutique rice products throughout Australia and New Zealand, and re-exports value added rice products to the UK, US, Ireland and Singapore.
